

## Junior Pennant – The finalists have been found

The business end of the 2014 Northland Junior Pennant competition got under way with semi-finals being played at Bay of Islands, Kerikeri Golf Club on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Top qualifiers Waipu showed they deserved their top seed position, dispatching the young Mangawhai team 3.5-0.5. The was result considerably closer than the score line suggests with three out of the four games going down to the final hole all square only for Waipu to come out on top.

The battle between second seeds Whangaroa and third place qualifiers Northland/The Pines was deadlocked at 2-2 after regulation sending the match into overtime with a sudden death playoff between the respective number ones from each team. Brook Kingi (Whangaroa) and Soktaerodh Sean (Northland/The Pines) needed just the one hole to decide it with Kingi prevailing with a par to Sean's bogey at the par 5 17<sup>th</sup>.

That leaves just the final and the playoff match for positions 3 and 4 to go at Whangarei Golf Club on Sunday 15 June – tee time is 10.00am.
