National Events

The conditions for these events are shown on the NZ Golf website

- National Teams Championship
- Home Links events for 18 and 9 holers
- National Gross Stableford Rosebowl (Iris Farrell domestic competition)

Stroke Play Championship

Silver and Bronze played in two divisions over 36 holes. 9 Hole Championships played over 18 holes. The Winners receive a button. Host applications to made to and allocated by Golf Northland Inc. for a different venue each year. The host club works with Golf Northland women's committee. A format has been written up to follow and this is distributed to that club well before the event.

Raewyn Harris 9 Hole Rosebowl

This is played on the same day as the 9 hole championships. The teams are to consist of 3 players. The winner is the team with the highest aggregate stableford score.

Gross Stableford Rosebowl – 36 holes. The domestic competition is for the **Iris Farrell Rosebowl** played alongside the district's Champ of Champs. The districts winning team's results are returned to NZ Golf for the National Competition.

Club Team

A club team will comprise of three players:

The Silver and Bronze champions and the Bronze championship runner-up; or the leading Silver Division player and the two leading Bronze Division players.

If a club has only an Open Championship (either stroke play or match play).

Should a player be a champion of more than one club, she may play as a member of the team for each club.

Substitutes

Silver and Bronze Stroke Play Championships: If a prescribed team member is unavailable the club may substitute the next available player who finished closest to the winner in her division.

Silver and Bronze Match Play Championships: If the Silver Champion is unavailable, the runner-up may be substituted. If either the Bronze champion or runner-up is unavailable, a

losing semi-finalist will be selected by lot. If a further replacement is required, the other semi-finalist will be eligible.

Open Match or Stroke Play Championship: If a prescribed team member (see Above for Open Championship) is unavailable, the club may substitute the next available player who finished closest to the winner in her division.

In all cases above, note that there is only one substitute option for any prescribed team member who is unavailable.

Tie

In the event of a tie, a countback will be made using the aggregate of each team's gross stableford points. Refer to NZ Golf's events conditions rules on their website.

Senior (65+) Champion of Champions (COC)

A Senior champion is to be 65 years and over. The player must have qualified at an event held at their club. The Senior COC competition is played over 18 holes on Saturday morning. Those playing in the Senior COC competition **only**, are allowed a cart without a medical certificate. A club's Senior COC representative is not allowed to represent their club in the Silver or Bronze COC district competition. For those senior champions who may be included in their club's Iris Farrell Rosebowl team in the 36 hole competition, the first 18 hole round will be counted in the Senior COC results.

Mary Rishworth Salver

This is played as an inter-club competition over 27 holes at a central venue. One Team of four players per club. Team colours are desired to be worn. Handicap index restriction is between 10.4 and 30.4. The winner is the club with the lowest aggregate scores. This is from the best 3 net scores after 18 holes from the best 3 nett scores after 9 holes. All players are to play the last nine holes from the same tee. This event is run by Golf Northland at a host club.

President's Tray and Shirley Rishards Gross

The scores from clubs Women's Open Tournaments are to be sent to the Women's President for the above trophies. An entry form will be sent out at the beginning of each year.

The handicap index is not to exceed 40.4

President's Tray is for the best 3 net scores from a participating club.

Shirley Rishards 3 points are allocated to the club providing the winning best gross score. 2 points to the runner up. One point to 3rd placing.
